Dear Parents

As we continue to enjoy some fairly pleasant weather I though I would touch base with you all to inform you of information that will be of use for the coming weeks.

<u>School Uniform</u>—We have a new school uniform to celebrate our 40th Anniversary in September. The uniform changes are a new jumper and cardigan which has a double edging trim in the school blue. We also have new blue ties which match the school colour as the original ties were in fact too dark. The new uniform will be available from Kids Kirkby after 20th June and Premier in Ormskirk, but they do not have a deliver date as yet.
